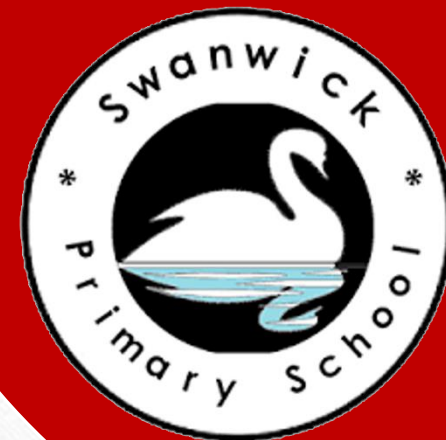
- Trousers or shorts- plain grey or black

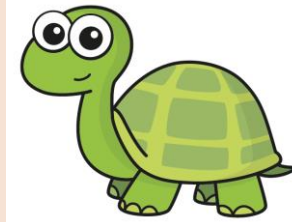

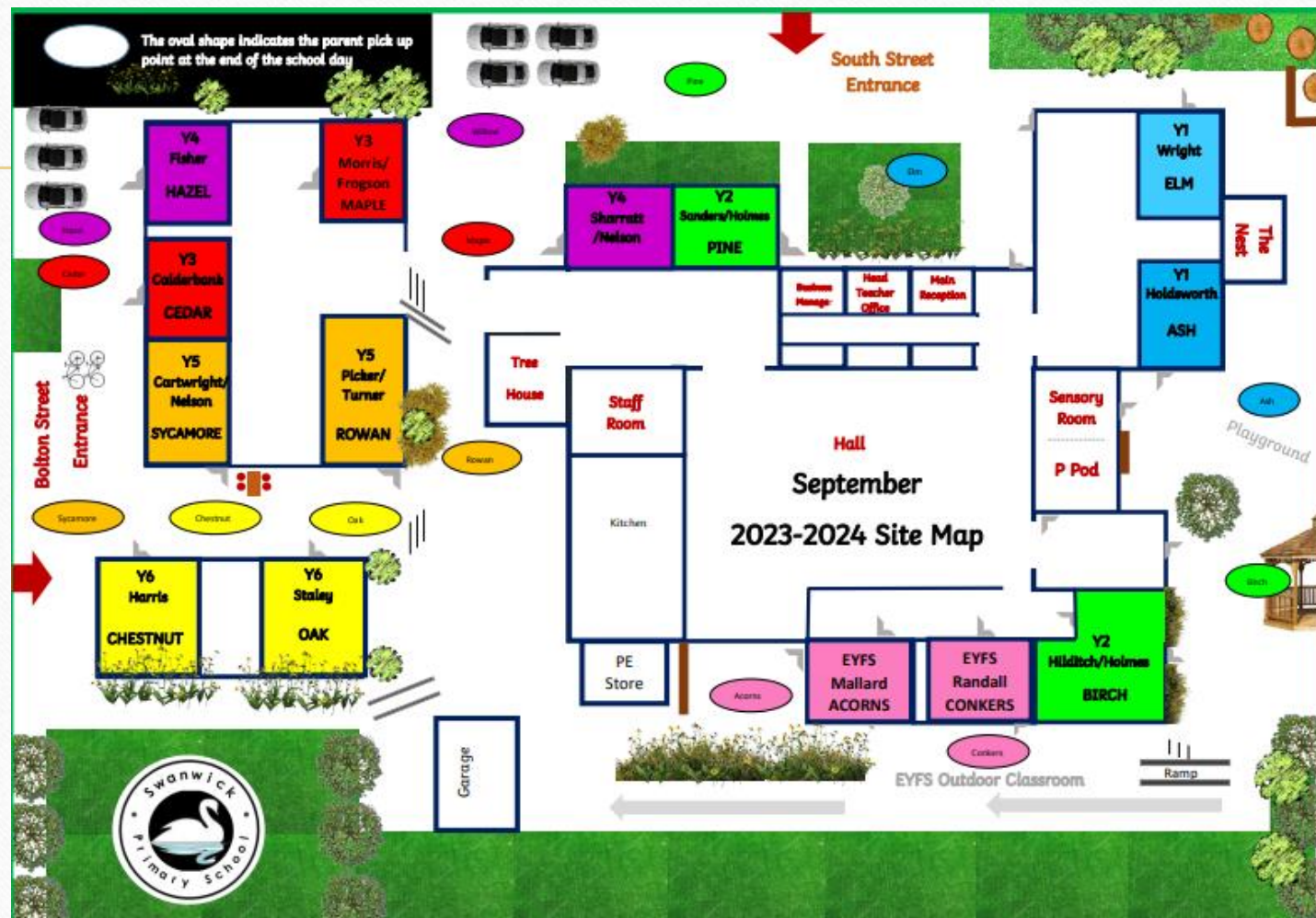
