## 24-25 Transition for Children starting in Reception

With Primary Offer Day fast approaching, we wanted to share the plan for our new EYFS children to join our school community. If you have a child potentially starting with us, we have some key dates below! Keep them free and further details will follow, after Easter Break.

Further update! We have been able to extract the data needed from our school system to begin setting up accounts. We are rolling this out Year by Year, starting with Year 2. Once this is complete, you will receive a Parent Hub message directing you to your emails to activate your account. You might want to install the Tapestry app on your phones in anticipation! We have to manually connect the adults to the children on the system, and this means there will be a delay in rolling this out. Year 2 should be set up by the 2<sup>nd</sup> week back in the new term and then each Year group will be activated week by week. Please do keep an eye out for messages about this on Parent Hub. We are initially setting this up for the first 2 Contacts on our school system-per child. Eventually, we will be able to make changes and add further contacts.

There are 5 Neuro Hubs that have been set up in Derbyshire to help children and their families. With **no formal referral or diagnosis needed**, the hubs offer children, young people up to the age of 25, their families and carers support and advice. It is a safe and supportive environment where you can ask questions about anything to do with neurodiversity. Families and carers can access help and advice on: being out and about, sleeping, eating, toileting, communication and interaction, education, work and play, sensory processing, crisis and behaviour.
